### COMBINED SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The I.S.E.E. Connecticut Valley Chapter has established a scholarship which is aimed at recognizing students who have the ability and ambition to seek and pave the direction they are handed. Everyone interested in Blasting, Construction or Mining is eligible.

To be eligible for a grant for the 2009 academic year you must be:

- a. Pursuing an associate, undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited college or university
  - b. In the process of applying or already accepted for college admission
  - c. Able to demonstrate a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.9 on a four point scale if you have already completed college course work.
  - d. Able to determine financial need
- \* Officers, Directors and Employees of the I.S.E.E. Connecticut Valley Chapter and their relatives will be eligible.

**DEADLINE:** March 4 2009

Recipients of renewable scholarships are expected to reapply by Jan. 31st of each year by submitting a letter of intent stating that they expect to continue their studies in the next academic year. A current copy of the student's transcript shall be attached.

All funds will be sent directly to the education institution. Failure to use any scholarship in the year for which it was intended will result in forfeiture. Upon acceptance, students will be required to sign an agreement that the student will complete the education for which the scholarship applies or return the funds.
